DAY'S IDEA; WHO GOD IS

Who made the universe and everything in it? God! Before anything else, God.

The Bible - God's word - tells us God has always been (Eternal). No beginning. Hard to understand - everything we know has a beginning. People, trees, animals, cars, buildings once didn't exist - and then made, came into being somehow

God alone always existed.

First sentence in the Bible: In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

God spoke and things came into existence. God said: let there be light - and there was light. Let there be stars - and there was stars.

Can't understand - revealed in His word - trustworthy - God cannot lie.

God therefore is very, very powerful. Unlimited. Could have created millions of universes if He wanted to. WRITE <u>ALL POWERFUL</u> ON BOARD

The universe very complex and amazing. Billions of stars and planets and moons each staying in place, no collisions. Planets rotating around the suns exactly the same speed and distance year after year.By God - no power on its own.

Life on earth fantastically complex, from the tiniest microbe to the biggest elephant. Salmon hatching/spawing cycle, butterflies migrate from Canada to Mexico. Our bodies very complex and superwell designed. God is ALL WISE.

God tells us in His Word: By wisdom the LORD founded the earth; by understanding He created the heavens.

No limit to God's wisdom /power to make a smooth-running immense universe. Neat planet with all the different species of animals, birds, fish, insects.

Does God know each one's thoughts right now? 5 years ago? Before He even created anything at all?

His Word. PSALM 139:4 You know my thoughts before i think them...Lord, before i say a word you already know it.

God knows everything in the past, present, future forever! ALL KNOWING. No limits

If God knows everything then He knows everything about each of us. Can't hide from God, Iie to God.

God is everywhere simultaneously. ALL PRESENT. Far beyond our universe, God is there.

God is awesome! Greater, stronger, wiser than can be imagined. We understand as much about God as a mouse understands about jet planes and skyscrapers and rocket ships.

Compared with God we can hardly do or know anything. Can't make anything out of nothing: we need to have something else first. Can't make this Bible without trees for paper and chemicals to make ink. And to make those i'd need other things.

We can only be in one place at one time. Think only one thought at a time. Bible says God's thoughts as much as all the grains of sand on the seashores. We can only see what our eyes look at, but God sees everything in the universe simultaneously. He even knows all the atoms inside the sun.

God gave us Bible: what we <u>need</u> to know about Him. If told us everything - it'd take a billion books. What He has done in the past - like creating the whole universe. What He is is doing now, what He will do in the future.

Tells us about people too We're His special creation. Been very involved with us from when He created the first man and woman, from which all the human race descended.

One of the most important things: What is right or wrong.

Many many people don't understand what is right or wrong. Somebody steals a gun. Someone steals the gun from him. He gets mad because: you're not supposed to steal

Bullies others at school because its fun, thinks there's nothing wrong. Someone bullies him - it's wrong! If you remind him he was bullying others he won't admit it's wrong

Many think hurting other people is good except if someone does the same to them. Many do good things, but also bad things and don't think it was bad. We need someone who knows and says what is truly good and bad, right and wrong. And that someone is God.

FLIP CHART TO DEUT.32:4 He is the Rock, His works are <u>perfect</u>, and all His ways are <u>just</u>. A faithful God who <u>does no wrong</u>, <u>upright</u> and just is He.

God can say what is right and wrong because only God is PERFECT. (UPRIGHT) He DOES NO WRONG.

Bad, or wrong, God's word calls that sin.

FLIP CHART TO ROMANS 3:23. For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard

God's glorious standard is to be PERFECT. To never do anything God would not do Himself. Do only good things God would do.

God tells us right and wrong in His commandments, found in Bible. Tell us what God says is good - and what is sin, what is wrong.

Even if you don't know Bible exists - you still know in your heart when you've done something wrong. (Conscience)

Break one of God's commandments = sin. Fallen short of God's glorious standard which is PERFECTION

If God became a human, like us, He would do all the good things His commandments tell us to do. He would be a PERFECT man UPRIGHT. He would never sin. Meet His own glorious standard. There was such a man we'll learn about at Kamp: Jesus.

God is one Person. But His Word tells us He is 3 Persons, yet still 1 God. God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. Each one of these 3 Persons are all God, all equal, yet all One. Not 3 separate Gods Symbol of the triangle, which is one but has 3 sides.

God the Son does not mean that God the Father created Him, The Father and the Son have always existed, had no beginning, always been God - along with God the Holy Spirit. All 3 are equally God, yet together they are 1 God

We can't understand it (We can't understand creation *ex nihlo*.) We must accept what God says in the Bible about Himself because it is true. I'll be speaking mostly about God the Father and God the Son, and later about God the Holy Spirit also. But when i say God, I mean one being in 3 Persons.

God is creator/owner/sustainer of everythying. We owe Him everything. Planet loaded w/ necessary things for man's life:water, food, minerals, wood, animals. Our life in His hands - every heartbeat and breath. We're not the most important - He is. What He says, goes. He can do with each one of us what He wants. King and ruler.

MEMORY VERSE. Romans 3:23 For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard.

DAY'S IDEA: MAN IS DISOBEDIENT AND GUILTY

Yesterday: we learned God made the heavens and earth. If God is ALL-GOOD then what He made must be ALL GOOD.

SHEET, GENESIS 1:31 God looked at everything He had made and it was very good.

Wasn't the terrible things today: no floods, forest fires, earthquakes, volcanoes or tidal waves that destroy towns and kill people. No poisonous snakes or insects or dangerous animals. Weather was always perfect. Abundant food to pick off the trees or bushes. No poisonous mushrooms. No diseases that sicken and kill.

The earth was the absolute best place, very different from now, where people get sick and die, where there's fear and pain and hunger etc

The last thing God created - human beings, the first man and woman, Adam and Eve. Created last because humans are most important. Made like God: think, feel, will, moral sense, self-conscious. God made Adam and Eve All good!

Adam and Eve had no diseases - none to get. Completely healthy, Perfect bodies and minds. Created RIGHTEOUS - had committed no sin. God hadn't given them any commandments yet: nothing to disobey. Knew God was RIGHTEOUS.

A and E created ALL GOOD. God can make choices, so He made man with ability to chose also: to do etiher right or wrong, to sin or obey.

We make choices all the time, all day long: do i do this, or that? Go this way, or that?

Because God made us with same ability to choose.

Adam and Eve saw God had given them a beautiful world to live in with everything they needed. God wanted the very best for them, for their children and all descendants. And God did this because He is Loving - He shows love to whom He wants.

We'll learn this week what kind of love it was and how very great it was.

A and E knew God loved them: (When you love somebodty, you give them the very best you have) But: did they love God?

.God created man to be in relationship with Him. (Define relationship) Talk, share feelings, love one another, care for one another, do things together, help one another, comfort one another, show one another how to do things. Marriages, parents and kids, brothers and sisters, friends)

Adam and Eve in a relationship with God. (God a Spirit, but still spoke to them. Theophany?) Talked to God, God talked with them. They probably had many questions, God had many things to show and tell them about the wonderful world He had made for them.

They depended on God for everything. Were to thank and praise God for who He was and all He had done.

God gave them beautiful garden called Eden to live in., Certain tree that God told them not to eat the fruit from.

READ KIDS GENESIS 2:15-17

God gave them a commandment. Adam and Eve could choose to obey it or disobey it. Eat or not eat.. To show they loved God or didn't love Him. And God says in His word that if you love Him you will obey His comandments

When we disobey any of God's commandments, what does the bible call that? Sin!

What did God say would happen to them if they ate the fruit? They would die!

- (1) physical death body dies.
- (2) spiritual death. Your spirit is your true life gives life to your body (Body is dead because spirit is gone). Thoughts, feelings, will, personality. Body is place your spirit inhabits, gives life to. Makes you who you are as a person. Spirit exists forever.

Spiritual death: separated from God - *no relationship with God any more*. At physical death, you'd' be away from God forever in a place of punishment.

God intended that A and E should never physically or spiritually die - they'd live in God's presence forever in a relationship with Him. But - only if they obeyed any commandments He gave them.

Why would God be so tough on them? Why would He cut A and E off from His very prescence, and punish them forever for just one sin?

Because: God is Perfect! That means He hates sin - hates any disobedience to any of His commandments *infinity*.

TURN PAD TO HABBAKUK 1:13. AND HAVE KIDS RECITE IT But you are pure and cannot stand the sight of evil.

Pure means without any sin - it means perfect. Sin to God is awful (rotten meat infested with maggots)

Also He loves righteousness - according to the commandments we find in His word. God's commandments or laws tells us what God Himself is like.

HAVE KIDS READ DEUT. 32:4 His deeds are perfect...He is a faithful God who does no wrong; how just and upright is He.

To be upright is to do only what is right.

The choice Adam and Eve made. READ KIDS GENESIS 3:6

Did Adam and Eve keep God's commandment? No! And what did God say would happen to them if they did not obey? They'd die.

FLIP CHART TO ROMANS 6:23. The wages of sin is death. Wages are payment. What you get for doing something. If you work for somebody, they pay you wages -money.

God's payment to us for our sin is death. Physical death - our bodies

die. And spiritual death - we are separated from God now and for eternity . He cannot have anything to do with us.

To be spiritually alive is to love God and want to obey Him. But because we sin, we can't love Him and we don't want to obey Him. We don't know anything about God, we're not interested in Him. That's spiritual death.

Does everybody die? If the wages of sin is death, and everybody dies then that must mean that everyone has done - what? Sinned. We have all sinned, and we're all going to die.

Who remebers yesterday's memory verse? For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard.

Adam and Eve committed 1 sin - and immediately fell short of God's glorious standard.

How many sins do you think that you and I and everybody else we know commit? Lots.

We're always sinning and falling short of God's glorious standard - perfection. Because even our thoughts can be sinful: jealous, mean, negative, greedy, resentful, etc..

Sin makes us spiritually dead, and because we're spiritually dead, we can only sin. And all cut off from God.

What we're going to learn this week is how God makes us spiritually alive again. How God removes our sin from us and makes us righteous again so that we can have a relationship with Him. Just like A and E before they sinned. And so we can spend eternity with Him in heaven.

MEMORY VERSE: Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.

DAY'S IDEA: GOD MUST JUDGE BUT GOD IS ALSO MERCIFUL.

REVIEW;

We've learned - God is All Good! Another word (starts with P) perfect!

Because God is perfect - how does He feel about sin? Hates it
Infinitely -

What is sin falling short of? God's glorious standard!
One sin in our whole lives - we'd fall short of His glorious standard - His

One sin in our whole lives - we'd fall short of His glorious standard - His perfection.

Sin is breaking, or disobeying something - what? God's commandments.

Any commandment in the Bible, i.e. You shall not steal, tells you God hates stealing of any kind. He perfectly honest, expects us to be same

Sin is against God (even if i hurt someone) because I'm breaking His law, and because He is our creator

Because God is perfect, and hates sin and all sin is breaking His law - He must judge us for our sins. To judge = declare something wrong. Pronounce person who did it guilty. Pronounce their punishment. Example of thief before magistrate.

God judges us for disobeying any of his commandments. If didn't judge wouldn't be perfect. Be sinning because He's letting us get away with doing wrong (Impossible -God perfect, can't ever sin.

He must judge us. Give us the payment, or wages for our sin. And what are the wages of sin?

Death! We die physically. Die spiritually: separated from God now, and forever in a place of terrible punishment. The Bible calls that ETERNAL DEATH

Very bad spot: we've all sinned, all going to be judged. But there is good news for us.

DEUTERONOMY 32:4 The Lord is kind and shows MERCY...He is merciful to all He has made.

To show MERCY is to NOT punish someone for wrongdoing. (Repeat). If God shows mercy to you, then He does not judge you for your sins - even though you have sinned.

He does not declare you guilty - even though you are guilty. And He does not punish you even though you deserve to be punished.

How can God Judge, and be Merciful at the same time even though we deserve only punishment? How does God make us as though we'd never sinned - therefore never deserve punishment?

How does He make us so we never fell short of His glorious standard - even though we fall short all the time?

How does He make us as sinless - as perfect - as righteous - as Himself? Just as if you'd never sinned? Because that is what you need to have eternal life in heaven with God.

God would rather not punish you because He knows how terrible the punishment would be. What if someone else was punished for your sins? Who else is there?

There is only one person. He must be human like us because He is going to be punished in the place of humans, to be our substitute (EXPLAIN SUBSTITUTE - ONE ATHLETE SUBBING IN FOR ANOTHER WHO IS INJURED.)

Substitute must be sinless. Never have sinned. If he did, He'd be just as guilty as the rest of us - and his punishment would be only for himself.

And - because God is perfect He wants only somebody who is Perfect to take the punishment of death for our sins. Then He can accept that punishment as perfect enough to pay for those sins.

Is there anyone, anywhere who is Perfect? God! God can be the only one who can take the penalty of death for us. But - how can God die? You can't kill God!

God could only die - if He became a human like us.

Remember on Sunday night: God is 3 Persons, but One God - God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit?

God the Father sent God the Son to earth to be born as a human - even though He would still remain fully God.

Very hard for us to understand: how can one person be fully human, yet be fully God? Yet God 's Word tells us this is so. God can do this because He is All-Powerful! And All-Wise.

Real meaning to Christmas? Not toys, gifts, eat lots get a vacation from school. But to celebrate the birth of God the Son as a human being whose name is Jesus Christ. Who was born on earth to be the way for us to have eternal life.

Jesus had a human stepfather, Joseph: but Joseph had nothing to do with his wife Mary becoming pregnant with Jesus God the Holy Spirit created Jesus as a human baby in Mary. He made God the Son a human body and spirit.

Why'd God the Father and God the Son do this? KIDS LOOK UP ROMANS 5:8, RECITE. God is loving - didn't want us puinished (even though had to).

MEMORY VERSE: John 3:17 God sent His Son into the world not to judge the world but to save the world

DAYS IDEA: CHRIST IS OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS
MATERIALS: CLEAN WHITE SWEATSHIRT, DIRTY SWEATSHIRT

Yesterday: God the Father is love, doesn't want to judge and punish us for our sins as we deserve, He sent God the Son to earth to be born fully human like us and to take the punishment in our place. Remember S-word

Can't kill God - a Spirit, immortal and can't be killed. But if God becomes human He can be put to death - as a human - though He still remains God

So Jesus was standing in for us - being our substituté. Born around 2019 years ago - why we number our years

Jesus was born into a race of people called the Jews. Very ancient, had worshipped God for thousands of years. (Only people, because God had chosen them to be His special people.) We know this from His word, the Bible, which has the history of the Jews and their relationship with God.

For the first 30 years of His life Jesus helped support his parents and younger brothers and sisters working as a carpenter. The last 3 years He travelled throughout the country where He was born, Judea, where the nation of israel is today. (Your counselors can show you where Israel is if they have maps in the backs of their bibles.)

In those 3 years He called people to believe in Him to receive eternal life. Worked many miracles - healing blind/deaf/mute/ crippled people, even raising people from the dead. Did these things to prove He came from God. Only God would have the power

Even though Jesus did many good things and told people the truth about God, he had enemies: religious leaders (the pharisees and scribes, teachers, bible experts) Jealous because all the people were listening to Jesus teach, and not them any more.

Also, Jesus told religious leaders their teaching was often wrong. They were very proud of their knowledge - made them very angry when Jesus told them they were false teachers.

Judea ruled by the Romans, conquered them years before. The Romans very harsh and cruel if anyone disobeyed them. Often some men in Judea trying to start a revolt against the Romans. Drive them out so the Jews could be free and rule themselves as before.

The pharisees and scribes worried: Romans would think Jesus might also start a revolt. Many people actually expected Him to. The Romans might crush the Jews and kill many of them, drive them right out of Judea.

So the religious leaders plotted to kill Jesus. They arrested Him, brought Him before a Roman court and accused Him of wanting to lead a revolt. The penalty for doing that was death, and death by crucifiction.

DESCRIBE CRUCIFIXION

Very important: God had planned all this in advance. It wasn't 'bad luck'. Jesus knew for much of His life He'd die on a cross because He was always in communication through prayer with His heavenly Father. Remember: He came to earth to die for our sins and crucifixion was the way that God had planned for His death to happen.

Jesus took on Himself our guilt and sin. CIRCLE <u>IN</u> AND DRAW ARROW OVER TO <u>JESUS</u> AND PRINT <u>IN</u> ON EITHER SIDE OF <u>S</u>

He took on the wages or penalty for our sin: death. And that is all our sins -past present and future. His death was the most painful of all to show how very serious sin is. That's why I made these letters form a CROSS. Jesus died on a cross to pay for our sin.

Also, Jesus accepted this horrible death to show how much He loved us. Jesus went to the cross willingly. He could have escaped it at any time, because He had the power from God to do so. But in fact He wanted to die for us - because that is why His heavenly Father (God the Father) had sent Him. He was always perfectly obedient to His heavenly Father and He loved Him so much. And He loved us so much too.

Jesus was perfectly righteous - didn't sin - even when He sufffered on the cross. In fact, He prayed for the men who were crucifying Him: Father, forgive them for they do not know what they're doing. And that prayer was for the Roman soldiers who were executing Him because they didn't know anything about Jesus - they were just soldiers under orders doing their job.

To go to heaven - to have eternal life - we saw that we have to have our sins paid for and to be as RIGHTEOUS as God Himself. As Righteous as Jesus.

J U UNRIGHTEOUS S U RIGHTEOUS

When Jesus took on our guilt and sin He became UNrighteous. He had no righteousness - as if He had never done on right/ good thing in His life.

We've learned that we are UNrighteous. We sin. We do things all the time that are NOT right. But God gives us the Righteousness of Christ. SWITCH RIGHTEOUS AND UNRIGHTEOUS AROUND.

God declares us to be as righteous as His Son Jesus. That does not mean that we'll never sin. Just that God the Father sees us without sin.

PUT ON FILTHY SWEAT SHIRT. Suppose this sweatshirt represents my sin. PUT ON CLEAN SWEATSHIRT OVER IT. Suppose this clean sweatshirt represents the righteousness that God gives me.

Can you see the dirty shirt underneath? No. You can only see the clean one. When God the Father looks at me He sees only the clean sweatshirt only the righteousness of Jesus.

Does He know there's a dirty sweatshirt underneath? Yes! God know everything! But - what matters to Him is the clean sweatshirt - that is, the righteousness of Christ which covers my sin -the dirty sweatshirt.

So: God makes us perfectly righteous by crediting us with His very

own righteousness.

There is no other way to be as righteous as God requires for eternal life. Most people think, I'm not such a bad person, so God ought to be satisfied enough and let me into His heaven.

But we don't set the standard by which we can go to heaven: God does, and it is His glorious standard - perfection - which is what God Himself is.

So Jesus died on the cross. *Do you think He remained dead?* No! He rose from the dead.

He died on Friday -which is why we observe Good Friday at Eastertime - and rose from the dead very early on Sunday - Easter Sunday.

Jesus could not stay dead. Why? Because, if death is the penalty or wages for sin, and Jesus never sinned - then Jesus could not stay dead.

He only died for *our* sins. And when that penalty was paid, on the cross, and He died, it was only a short time and He would rise from the dead. And He is back in heaven today.

All this is wonderful news, but it won't do you any good unless you do one important thing: You must believe in Jesus, that He will save you. And we'll talk about that tomorrow. But don't hesitate to ask your counselor what that means right now.

MEMORY VERSE: Romans 3:22 We are made right with God by placing our faith in Jesus Christ.

DAY'S IDEA: JESUS MUST BE SAVIOR AND LORD

Yesterday: God makes us as righteous as Himself so we can have eternal life. Jesus, on the cross, paid for our sins / our unrighteousness. We can have His perfect righteousness. But - only if we do something. Believe in Him

Believing in Him not just agreeing He exists. But means believing that Jesus is the only one who can save you. God's word calls Jesus our SAVIOR. A savior is someone who saves you from something terrible, like death or defeat. And Jesus will save you from God the Father's Judgment: eternal death separated forever from Him and punished.

CHART:

BELIEVE -Jesus paid for your sins

BELIEVE His righteousness can be your righteousness

BELIEVE He will forgive you for your sins

BELIEVE He will give you eternal life

You just have to tell Jesus, in a simple prayer, that you believe all these things. Ask Him to forgive you for your sins. Tell Him that you believe He has done everything you need for eternal life. That you trust Him to give you eternal life, and you want Himto be your SAVIOR and your LORD.

We'll talk in a minute about what that means to have Jesus as your LORD. (ADD 'BELIEVE IN HIM AS YOUR LORD 'TO CHART)

We saw in Romans 6:23 that the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Do you have to do anything to receive a gift? No, it's just given to you. Gifts are free -or else, they're not gifts. They're payment or rewards for something you do.

You don't have to do anything to receive God's gift of eternal life - because Jesus did everything for you. You just need to ask Him for that gift. Salvation is God's love-gift to us.

God isn't interested in good we do to try get eternal life as a reward

He is only interested in what Jesus did to make us righteous, because He did it perfectly. Because Jesus acted according to God's glorious standard.

I said we need to ask Jesus to be our Savior and our LORD, Lord means one whom we obey. Our Master.

When Adam and Eve disobeyed God they were telling God we don't want you to be our Lord. We don't want you to tell us what to do. We want to be our own Lords, and do what we want. We think that what we want to do is better than what you want.

And God didn't' stop them, Their choice to be their own Lord and Master. But ever since then, every person on earth has been their own Lord and Master because they have rejected God. And like Adam and Eve, they sin and sin and sin. World filled with people hurting people, hating, killing, fighting, harming, stealing, envying. All the sins you could ever name. Breaking every one of God's commandments.

If you don't have God as your master and Lord, all you get is sin and suffering. The Bible says we are all slaves to sin, Sin is all we can do. Even when we do a good thing, it is for selfish reasons - to make ourselves look good to ourselves or others.

But Jesus saves you not just from the wages of sin but from being a slave to sin. He changes your heart from wanting to be your own Lord to making Him your Lord. If you make Jesus your Lord then He will help you obey His commandments. He will help you break free from slavery to sin.

Jesus told some people one time: Why do you call me Lord, Lord, and do not do what i say? These people were just pretending that Jesus was their Lord. But actually they just wanted to keep on disobeying Him. They were no different than Adam and Eve: they wanted themselves and not God to be their Lord.

So much of the hurt and pain we cause ourselves - and cause others - is because we want to be our own Lord. To belong to Christ - to be one of Christ's people - what is called a Christian - you must want to have Him as your Lord.

To help you to obey Him, He will give you the Holy Spirit. You'll remember we said that God was 3 Persons, each God, yet altogether 1 God. And that the Holy Spirit was one of the 3. The Bible speaks of Him as the Spirit of God or the Spirit of Christ. When you believe in Jesus as your savior, you will receive the Holy Spirit, who will live in your heart. And He will teach you what it means to make Jesus your Lord.

If Jesus is your Lord, He will guide you and help you through life. He will show you what is right and wrong according to His commandments, and He will help you to obey Him. He can give you a different, better life - one of joy and peace that you can't find on your own.

As Christians we still can sin - we won't be perfect. But when we do sin, we need to just ask God to forgive us, and He will. He can do that because that sin was paid for by Jesus on the cross. When we sin as Christians, Our sins offend God but he no longer judges us guilty - because Jesus was judged in our place, as our substitute. So our asking God's forgiveness is like when one friend offends another and asks forgiveness - and the friend will forgive because he is a friend.

If you're a Christian you'll never never need to worry about God judging you or finding you guilty: because Jesus was found guilty and punished in your place. Remember we said: He was your substitute so you'd never have to be found guilty and be punished.

God communicates – He tells us things (the Bible). Made us to communicate: we do it all the time. Most important: communicate w/ Him. PRAYER: talking to God. Thanking. Sharing troubles/problems. Asking forgiveness. Asking for help, guidance, safety. Praising.

If you are a Xn, God has adopted you. You're His child now. So you can talk to \Him anytime, anywhere, about anything. He will listen because \he is your Father. (Why prayers start w/ 'Our Father)

Remember: not everybody is child of God just because \he created them, Only those who've trust in Jesus, \his Son, for eternal life

God loves you if you are His child – never lose His love (as can happen with human fathers). ROMANS 8:35-39. READ IT ALOUD, HAVE KIDS
