- Water bottle with child's name

- Running shoes and another pair of outdoor shoes
- at least three complete changes of clothes, including underwear
- Girls – one-piece swimsuit, towel
- Boys – swim trunks, towel
- Toothbrush, toothpaste, comb/brush, soap, washcloth, deodorant, etc

Note: rough terrain and lots of activities means flip-flops, crocs and sandals are not adequate for camp. Please see that your child has sturdy shoes that provide support for feet and ankles, to avoid injury.

During camp electronic devices, extra food, knives, matches and money are not allowed, and will be safely stored for campers until the week at camp is finished.
